






St. Paul's Mission School, an Anglo Indian Christian Missionary School, was started by the women members of St. Paul's Cathedral, Kolkata. In 1884 the foundation stone of the school was laid at 5, Scott Lane, Kolkata 9, by the Lady Carmichael. Rev. Jackson was the first Rector of the school. The school today is owned and controlled by the Diocese of Calcutta, Church of North India, headed by the Bishop of Calcutta. The school is a large, modern and well equipped co-educational institution catering to students from Nursery to Class XII.


A continuous effort in providing an education that is transformative and empowering to the children will help them take their rightful place in society and develop into mature and responsible citizens of the country.






ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND ROBOTICS CLASSES
